BYPASS ON NATIONAL HIGHWAY-730C

be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has taken/proposes to take any steps to construct a bypass road on the proposed National Highway-730C in the outskirts of the densely populated Katra-Khudaganj town under Shahjahanpur Parliamentary constituency of Uttar Pradesh;
(b) whether the Government has received requests from the public representatives in this regard and if so, the details thereof; and
(c) the details of action taken/proposed in this regard?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

(a) to (c) The Ministry notified the highway starting from its junction with NH-730B near Bisalpur, connecting Miranpur Katra, Fatehgarh and terminating at its junction with NH-34 near Bewar in the State of Uttar Pradesh as National Highway (NH) NH-730C in March, 2018.

The Ministry has taken up development of NH-730C to two lane NHs standards with paved shoulder configurations in four packages under Green National Highway Corridor Project (GNHCP) with World Bank loan assistance in entire 144.10 km length, with scheduled completion in a phased manner by November, 2024; the scope of works do not include construction of any bypass road for Katra-Khudaganj town under Shahjahanpur Parliamentary constituency of Uttar Pradesh; at present there is no proposal for construction of the bypass.

Development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs), including newly notified NHs, is a continuous process and works are accordingly taken up on these NHs from time to time to keep them in traffic worthy conditions based on traffic density, inter se priority and availability of funds.

The Ministry duly considers the requests of public representatives from time to time while undertaking development and maintenance works on NHs.
