As on November' 2023, Projects of 26,418 km have been awarded and 15,045 km length have been completed. Status of Bharatmala Pariyojana state-wise is annexed. An amount of Rs. 4.10 Lakh crore has been spent under Bharatmala Pariyojana upto October' 2023.**
