**Digitisation of GPs**

Will the Minister of PANCHAYATI RAJ be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that out of 2,71,102 Gram Panchayats (GPs) in the country, only 2,19,889 GPs have computers facility;
- (b) if so, the timeline for supplying computers to every GP in the country to achieve the goal of digitisation of functioning of GPs;
- (c) the timeline fixed for achieving broadband connectivity in all Gram Panchayats by 2024-25; and
- (d) the update on the progress made towards this connectivity goal, State-wise?

**ANSWER**

- (a) As per the information available, out of 269073 Gram Panchayats (GPs)/ Traditional Local Bodies (TLBs), 226063 GPs have been computerized.
- (b) Panchayat being State subject, providing computers for Gram Panchayats (GPs) is primarily the responsibility of States. However, under the revamped Rashtriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan (RGSA) scheme approved for implementation from 01.04.2022 to 31.03.2026, has been supplementing the efforts of all States/UTs with focus on NE States, towards supporting functioning of GPs by providing computers as proposed by States/UTs in their Annual Action Plan and approved by Central Empowered Committee on a limited scale. Apart from this, the untied/ basic grants under 15th Finance Commission can also be used by Rural Local Bodies (RLBs) for computerization of GPs.
- (c) Bharat Net project is being implemented in a phased manner by Department of Telecommunications to provide broadband connectivity to all the Gram Panchayats and equivalent in the country. As on date, over 2.12 lakh GPs have been made Service Ready under the Bharat Net project in the country. The targets of BSNL for providing Fibre to the Home (FTTH) connections to all GPs through Bharat Net by 2024-25.
- (d) State-wise progress towards connectivity goal is at Annexure-I.
