Incubators in Fisheries Sector

352. SHRI GYANESHWAR PATIL:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING
मत्स्यपालन, पशुपालन और डेयरी मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has launched a dedicated business incubator, the first of its kind in the country, to nurture fisheries start-ups in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) is the implementing agency for incubators in fisheries sector;
- (d) if so, whether NCDC has identified batches of incubators in the States;
- (e) if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) the details of other steps being taken in the fisheries sector under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY), State-wise including Madhya Pradesh?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

(SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

(a) to (e): The Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) implemented by the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, *inter-alia* envisages for establishment of Fisheries Incubation Centers (FICs) with a view to nurture fisheries start-ups in the country.

National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) has been notified as one of the End Implementing Agencies under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY). With financial support under PMMSY, NCDC has in November, 2021 set up a Fisheries Business Incubation Centre (LIFIC) at its Gurugram, Haryana campus. It is reported that NCDC completed 11 batches of incubators at the LIFIC and the state-wise details of such incubators as reported by NCDC is furnished at Annexure-I.

(f): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying is implementing a flagship scheme namely “Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY)” with an investment of ₹20,050 crore in fisheries sector for a period of 5 years with effect from the financial year 2020-21 in all the States and Union Territories including Madhya Pradesh. The PMMSY intends to address critical gaps in fish production and productivity, quality, technology, post-harvest infrastructure and management, modernization and strengthening of value chain, traceability, establishing a robust fisheries management framework and fishers’ welfare. The Department of Fisheries, during the last financial years (2020-21 to 2022-23) and current year 2023-24 accorded approvals to the proposals of various States/UTs and other implementing agencies to the tune of Rs. 17118.62 crore including proposals of Government of Madhya Pradesh for Rs. 747.57 crore for development of fisheries and aquaculture in the State. State/UT-wise details of the proposals approved under PMMSY are furnished at Annexure-II.
