**SPMRM IN TELANGANA**

**357. DR. G. RANJITH REDDY:**

**Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether it is true that Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (SPMRM) was over last year;**
- (b) if so, whether it is true that there are still more than 1650 works which are yet to be completed under the above Mission in Telangana;**
- (c) if so, the details of works pending, district-wise;**
- (d) the time by which the works are going to be completed;**
- (e) whether it is true that no budgetary allocation has been made for this Mission in 2023-24; and**
- (f) if so, the manner in which the Ministry is going to complete the pending works in Telangana?**

**ANSWER  
MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT  
(SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)**

**(a): The Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (SPMRM) was initially launched in 2016 for a period of up to March 2020. 31st March 2022 has been declared as the “sunset date” for the Mission. One-time final sanction has been given by the Government of India for release of funds under the Mission up to 31st March, 2023, for those works which were ongoing as on 31.03.2022.**

**(b): As on 29th November 2023, there are 1425 works which are ongoing across the 17 Rurban clusters in the State of Telangana.**

**(c): The district-wise details of ongoing of work in the State of Telangana is given at Annexure 1.**

**(d): The State of Telangana has communicated to the Ministry that the works will be completed by 31st December 2023.**

**(e): Since 31st March 2022 has been declared as the sunset date for the scheme, a one-time sanction was accorded for release of funds till 31st March 2023 for ongoing works pending as on sunset date. Hence, no budgetary allocation has been made for 2023-24.**

**(f): The Ministry releases funds to the States/Union Territories (UTs) and the State/UTs are mandated to implement the scheme and to get the works completed. The Ministry, however, monitors the progress of work completion and fund utilisation made by the State/UTs through quarterly meetings, field visits and analysis of monthly progress. Review of progress is an ongoing process which the Ministry undertakes for all states, including Telangana.**
