MATERIAL COMPONENTS DUES UNDER MGNREGS

409. SHRIMATI KANIMOZHI KARUNANIDHI:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details regarding the pending wage dues and material component dues under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) till date, State and district-wise including Thoothukudi district of Tamil Nadu;
- (b) whether the entire funds allocated for the MGNREGS have got exhausted in the month of October, 2023;
- (c) if so, the measures taken to disburse funds to the beneficiaries on time;
- (d) whether the beneficiaries are given any receipts mentioning their pending dues in case of delay in wage payment; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the manner in which beneficiaries are notified about their pending dues?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a): Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) is a demand driven wage employment scheme. Fund release is a continuous process. Government of India releases material and admin funds to State Government and State Government releases the fund to its Districts accordingly. Government of India does not release material funds directly to the District.

(d)&(e): Beneficiaries is eligible for wage payment within 15 days after the completion of work. A beneficiary can find the pending dues of wage payment through the report R1.1.4 of Gram Panchayat report of the concerned state. Also, a provision has been made in Janmanrega App to check the status of wage payment of a beneficiary against the work done by her/him. The beneficiary can check the details just by providing Job card number.
