MODERNISATION OF RURAL AREAS

423. SHRI VIJAY KUMAR:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has formulated any schemes for modernisation of the rural areas of Bihar;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details and the number of schemes being implemented in Bihar for development of each of the deprived persons in rural areas of Bihar?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a) to (c): The Department of Rural Development (DoRD), Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD) is implementing a number of welfare schemes in all States/UTs including Bihar, to alleviate poverty in rural areas and to bring about overall improvement in the quality of life of areas, people rural strengthening of opportunities, providing minimum guaranteed employment, promoting self-employment, skilling of rural youths in various useful trades and entrepreneurship, infrastructure development and provision of social Mahatma Gandhi assistance. These include **National** Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS), Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana - Gramin (PMAY-G), Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM), Deen Dayal Upadhayay - Gramin Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETIs) and National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP). Apart from this, Department of Land Resources (DoLR), MoRD

is implementing Watershed Development Component (WDC) of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) which is principally for development of rainfed portions of net cultivated area and culturable wastelands.

However, this Ministry has not formulated any scheme specifically for modernization of the rural areas of Bihar.
