CLEANING OF MANHOLES

440. SHRIMATI APARUPA PODDAR:

Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has deployed manhole cleaning robots, if so, the details thereof, State-wise and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether the Government intends to conduct a survey on the number of manual scavengers and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the number of manual scavengers identified in the survey conducted in 2018, State-wise;
- (d) the number of deaths occurred while the person was cleaning sewer/septic tank during each of the last five years, State-wise;
- (e) the reasons for which 236 districts have not submitted a report regarding manual scavenging on the "Swachh Abhiyan" mobile app; and
- (f) whether any action/fine has been levied on these 236 districts, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT (SHRI RAMDAS ATHAWALE)

- (a): Data of deployment of man hole cleaning robots is not maintained centrally.
- (b): Yes, Sir. Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide Order dated 20.10.2023 in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 324/2020 directed for Nationwide Survey of Manual Scavengers.
- (c): 44,217 manual scavengers have been identified in National Survey of Manual Scavengers initiated in 2018 at the behest of the NITI Aayog. State-wise details of identified manual scavengers is at **Annexure-I.**
- (d): The Number of death occurred while cleaning of sewer/septic tanks during last five years and current year is given at **Annexure-II.**
- (e) and (f): As per the "Prohibition of Employment as Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Act, 2013 (MS Act, 2013)" manual scavenging is a prohibited activity in the country with effect from 6.12.2013. All districts have been requested either to declare themselves free from manual scavenging or upload the data of insanitary latrine and manual scavengers associated with it on "Swachhta Abhiyan" Mobile App. As on 29.11.2023, out of 766 districts in the country, 714 districts, have reported themselves as manual scavenging-free.
