Will the Minister of Food Processing Industries be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that India's ultra-processed food sector grew at a compound annual growth rate of 13.37 per cent in retail sales value from 2011 to 2021;
- (b) whether the Government has decided to implement a nutrient-based tax model in the country and if so, the details and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) whether the Government plans to reduce taxes on healthier food products and if so, the details therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

- (a): As per the latest Annual Survey of Industries (2019-20), the total output of the registered units engaged in production of the food products and beverages increased at a compound annual growth rate of 7.77% from 2011-12 to 2019-20. The retail sales data for the value-added/processed food products is not available.
- **(b) & (c):** GST rates/rate slabs/exemptions applicable on supply of goods and services are prescribed on the recommendations of the GST Council, which is a constitutional body comprising of representatives from States/UTs and Centre. There is no such recommendation from the GST Council.
