Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्री be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has decided to extend the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PMGKAY) for five more years and if so, the details thereof;

(b) the State and month-wise details of Central allocation of foodgrain distribution during each of the last three years and the current year;

(c) the total number of people who have been benefitted by PMGKAY in the State of Tamil Nadu, Odisha and Maharashtra during the above period;

(d) the challenges faced by the Government in the implementation of the scheme;

(e) whether the Government proposes to further extend the scheme and if so, the steps taken by the Government to reach individuals not covered under the scheme; and

(f) whether the Government has assessed the performance of PMGKAY scheme and if so, the outcome of the assessment and the corrective steps taken to improve the PMGKAY scheme?

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### A N S W E R MINISTER OF STATE FOR MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a): The Central Government, in order to remove the financial burden of the poor beneficiaries and to ensure nationwide uniformity and effective implementation of the Act has decided to continue to provide free food grains to about 81.35 crore NFSA beneficiaries (i.e. Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) households and Priority Households (PHH) beneficiaries) under the PMGKAY for a period of five years with effect from 1st January, 2024.

(b): A statement indicating the State/UT-wise allocation of foodgrains during the last three years and current year is at Annexure.

(c): The number of beneficiaries covered in the State of Tamil Nadu, Odisha and Maharashtra are as follows:

(d): No State/UT has reported any difficulty or challenges in implementation of the PMGKAY.

(e): As explained in part (a) above.

(f): The Government has engaged Monitoring Institutions (MIs) of repute to undertake concurrent evaluation of the implementation of National Food Security Act, 2013 (NFSA) in all States/UTs for 03 years (2020-23). The questionnaires devised for the evaluation exercise also covered few. Reports submitted by the MIs of the surveyed households indicate that rations under PMGKAY have been provided free of cost since January 2023 to eligible beneficiaries during the period of survey.
