- (a) whether South Western Railway (SWR) has proposed a 287-km circular rail network on the outskirts of Bengaluru to decongest the city's traffic and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has set any timeframe to complete the said rail project and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the estimated cost of the proposed rail project?

Further steps on this project will depend upon the outcome of DPR and support of State Government.
