- (c) if so, whether this will enable local artisans to become part of the global supply chain and to increase demand for their intricate work; and
- (d) if so, the details and present status thereof along with the funds sanctioned/beneficiaries identified, State-wise?

**(a) to (c):** The Scheme PM Vishwakarma envisages to provide end-to-end holistic support to artisans and craftspeople who work with their hands, using tools, in the 18 trades covered. Through the implementation of the Scheme, the beneficiaries of unorganized sector will be able to scale-up their operations, modernize/upgrade their tools and business, and enter the formal economy as entrepreneurs and contribute towards the larger goal of nation building. The objective of the Scheme is also to provide a platform for brand promotion and market linkages to help them access new opportunities for growth to the eligible beneficiaries. Marketing support in the form of quality certification, branding, advertising, publicity and other marketing activities would be extended to the beneficiaries to improve their linkage to value chain of MSMEs and established companies.

**(d):** PM Vishwakarma Scheme is a Central Sector Scheme with budget outlay of Rs. 13,000 crores for its implementation during the period of 2023-24 to 2027-28. As on 04.12.2023, the total number of enrolment of artisans and craftspeople are 22,80,756 against which the total successful registration of the beneficiaries are 16,233 after three levels of verification. The State-wise details of successful registration of the beneficiaries are at **Annexure-I**.
