- (b) whether the 50% transport subsidy to Kisan rails has been discontinued;
- (c) if so, the details and the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government to continue Kisan rails for the benefit of the farmers to transport their products like fruits and vegetables?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 640 BY DR. TALARI RANGAIAH TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 06.12.2023 REGARDING KISAN RAILS.

- (a) to (c): Since the inception of Kisan Rail service on 7th August 2020 and upto 15thNovember 2023, Railways have operated 2,364 Kisan Rail services, transporting approximately 7.93 lakh tonnes of perishables. The 50% subsidy on transportation of fruits and vegetables through Kisan rail continued till 31.03.2022. Thereafter 45% subsidy was given by Ministry of Railways.
- (d) Potential circuits for movement of vegetables, fruits and other perishables are identified in consultation with Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare and Agriculture/Animal Husbandry/ Fisheries Departments of State Governments as well as local bodies and agencies, Mandis etc., and on the basis of operational feasibility, Kisan Rail services are run.
