#### **ALLOCATION OF FOODGRAINS TO KERALA**

667. ADV. A.M. ARIFF:

Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the allocation of foodgrains to the State of Kerala reduced from an average 16 lakh tons per year to 14.25 lakh tons per year after the implementation of the National Food Security Act and if so, the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether the Government has received any representation from Kerala for increasing the foodgrains allocation under tide over scheme for distribution for NPS and NPNS households in the State and if so, the action taken thereon;
- (c) whether the Government intends to reinstate the allocation of wheat under tide over scheme to Kerala which was stopped w.e.f. June 2022 and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the number of NPS and NPNS ration card holders and allocation of foodgrains under tide over scheme for FY 2021-22 and FY 2022-23, State and UT-wise?

#### ANSWER

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a): Allocation of foodgrains to States/Union Territories (UTs) under the National Food Security Act, 2013 (NFSA) is made on the basis of identification of beneficiaries reported by the States/UTs within the State/UT-wise coverage of population determined by the then Planning Commission, and foodgrains entitlement prescribed under the Act i.e. 35 kg per household per month for households covered under Antyodaya Anna Yojana and 5 kg per person per month for Priority households. The Act further provides that if on the above basis, annual foodgrains allocation to any State/UT is lower than the average annual offtake during 2010-11 to 2012-13 under erstwhile normal Targeted Public Distribution System, the same shall be protected. The foodgrains entitlement of States/UTs is specified in Schedule-IV of the Act. As per Schedule-IV, the State of Kerala is entitled to 1425049 tons (including 424751 tons as tide over allocation) of foodgrains per annum.

The coverage of beneficiaries determined for the State of Kerala under the NFSA is 154.80 lakh persons and the State has already identified the beneficiaries under the Act upto maximum permissible limit. Accordingly, 85459.885 MT of foodgrains per month are being allocated to the State Government at NFSA Prices. In addition to this 33294.198 MT of foodgrains per month are being allocated under "tide over" to protect the average annual offtake during 2010-11 to 2012-13. Thus, the State of Kerala is receiving 118754.083 MT of foodgrains per month (1425049 MT of foodgrains per annum) which is as per maximum permissible limit under the Act.

- (b): Request for enhancement of allocation of foodgrains under "tide over" over and above the entitlement had been received from State Government of Kerala. The State was informed that the criteria for allocation of foodgrains is uniformly applicable for all the States/UTs, therefore, the request of a particular State for enhancement of "tide over" allocation over and above its entitlement cannot be agreed to.
- (c): In order to ensure management of foodgrain stocks as per norms, to position rice stock for distribution of fortified Rice and to ease the pressure on the logistics, the Government had revised the allocation of food grains in regard to 12 States/UTs (including Kerala) under NFSA/Tide Over category. Tide over allocation was revised for 3 State i.e. Uttarakhand, Kerala and Tamil Nadu by replacing wheat with equivalent quantity of rice. The revised allocation was initially applicable upto 31.03.2023, which was extended upto June, 2023 for all the 12 States (including Kerala). The allocation was again reviewed in May, 2023 in consultation with Food Corporation of India and it was decided to continue the revised allocation under NFSA/Tide Over further from July, 2023 onwards for all 12 States/UTs (including Kerala).
- (d): As per the guidelines, the "tide over" foodgrains are distributed through Targeted Public Distribution System. Further details regarding distribution are left to the States/UTs. The data of non-NFSA beneficiaries to which "tide over" foodgrains is distributed is not maintained by the Central Government.

A statement indicating the State/UT-wise details of allocation of foodgrains under "tide over" for the financial year 2021-22 and 2022-23 is at Annexure.
