- (a) the number of Skill Development Centres in various States, including Delhi and Jharkhand under the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), district-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has formulated any scheme to provide employment to the youth getting training from the said Training Centres; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof

(a) Under the Govt. of India, Skill India Mission (SIM) aims at Skilling, Re-Skilling and Up-Skilling to ensure all young Indians are prepared for the large number of opportunities coming up as the economy expands and India moves from the 10th largest economy to 3rd largest economy in the world. SIM is aimed at giving access to all youth in India to get future ready, Industry ready skill. The district wise number of Skill Development Centres / Training Centres in various States including Delhi and Jharkhand under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) is given at Annexure. Since the details in aforesaid Annexure are too lengthy, it is uploaded on Ministry's website at <https://msde.gov.in/en/useful-links/parl-ques/lok-sabha>.

(b) & (c) Under PMKVY, Skill training is imparted through Short Term Training (STT) and Up-skilling and Re-skilling through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). Under PMKVY, placement opportunities have been provided to STT certified candidates, and RPL involves the process of certification of already existing skills. MSDE has launched a single online platform for skilling i.e. Skill India Digital (SID). Job Exchange option as available on SID, helps in enabling candidates to search for available jobs and apply accordingly. The details of trained candidates under PMKVY 4.0 are made available on Skill India Digital for connecting with potential employers. Under STT component of PMKVY, since 2015 to 31.10.2023, 24.38 lakh candidates have been reported as placed out of 59.16 lakh certified candidates through these training centres.
