(c) In order to popularize jute produce and jute industry along with supporting livelihood of large number of farmers and workers, the Government has enacted the Jute Packaging Materials (Compulsory Use in Packing Commodities) Act, 1987. It specifies the commodities and the extent to which they are mandatorily required to be packed in Jute Packaging Materials manufactured in India from raw jute produced in India. The Government has recommended the level of reservation $100 \%$ in food grains and $20 \%$ in sugar since the last six years. The Government procures $70 \%$ of the total production of jute goods.

Further, the Government has approved an Umbrella Scheme namely National Jute Development Program (NJDP) with total outlay of Rs 485.58 crore for implementation during 2021-22 to 2025-26 for over all development and promotion of Jute Sector.
