NEW TRAINS FROM UDAIPUR TO SOUTH INDIA

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is considering to start new trains from Udaipur City Railway Station to Hyderabad, Chennai and Bengaluru cities in South India;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (c) Presently, Udaipur is connected to Bengaluru by 01 Pair of train service. For travelling to Hyderabad and Chennai, passengers of Udaipur may avail services from Chittaurgarh which is connected to Chennai and Hyderabad by 01 pair of Express services and 02 pairs of Express services respectively. Further, introduction of new train services is an ongoing process on Indian Railways subject to operational feasibility, traffic justification, resource availability, etc.
