FUNCTIONAL AIRPORTS IN NORTH-EASTERN REGION

735. SHRI VINCENT H. PALA Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION

be pleased to state:-

- (a) the details of functioning/non-functioning Airports in the North-Eastern Region (NER) States and the reasons for non-functioning of these Airports;
- (b) the number of Airports under construction and the time by which these are likely to be completed;
- (c) the details of privatised airports as on date; and
- (d) the number of sanctioned and vacant posts in every airport in NER, State-wise?

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD))

- (a): The details of functioning/ non-functioning Airports in the North-Eastern Region (NER) States are attached as Annexure-I.;
- (b): Government of India has accorded 'In-Principle' approval for setting up of 21 new Greenfield Airports across the country namely, Mopa in Goa, Navi Mumbai, Shirdi and Sindhudurg in Maharashtra, Kalaburagi, Vijayapura, Hassan and Shivamogga in Karnataka, Dabra (Gwalior) in Madhya Pradesh, Kushinagar and Noida (Jewar) in Uttar Pradesh, Dholera and Rajkot in Gujarat, Karaikal in Puducherry, Dagadarthi, Bhogapuram and Orvakal (Kurnool) in Andhra Pradesh, Durgapur in West Bengal, Pakyong in Sikkim, Kannur in Kerala and Hollongi (Itanagar) in Arunachal Pradesh across the country. Out of these, 12 Greenfield airports viz. Durgapur, Shirdi, Kannur, Pakyong, Kalaburagi, Orvakal (Kurnool),

Sindhudurg, Kushinagar, Itanagar, Mopa, Shivamogga and Rajkot have been operationalised. The timeline for completion of airports depends upon various factors such as land acquisition, mandatory clearances, removal of obstacles, financial closure etc. by the respective airport developers.

- (c): As on date, Airports Authority of India (AAI) has leased out eight of its airports at Delhi, Mumbai, Lucknow, Ahmedabad, Mangaluru, Jaipur, Guwahati and Thiruvananthapuram for better operations, management and development of these airports under Public Private Partnership (PPP). The details of companies that currently run these airports are as follows:

- (2) Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport, Mumbai M/s Mumbai International Airport Limited (MIAL)
- (3) Chaudhary Charan Singh International Airport, Lucknow M/s Lucknow International Airport Limited (LIAL)
- (4) Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel International Airport, Ahmedabad M/s Ahmedabad International Airport Limited (AIAL)
- (5) Mangaluru International Airport M/s Mangaluru International Airport Limited (MaIAL)
- (6) Jaipur International Airport M/s Jaipur International Airport Limited (JIAL)
- (7) Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport, Guwahati M/s Guwahati International Airport Limited (GIAL)
- (8) Thiruvananthapuram International Airport M/s TRV-Kerala International Airport Limited (TIAL);
- (d): The details of sanctioned and vacant posts of Airports in NER are attached as Annexure-II.
