#### INTER-STATE CONNECTIVITY IN WAYANAD

#### 742. SHRI RAHUL GANDHI:

#### Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

- (a) the initiatives being taken to improve inter-State connectivity in Wayanad parliamentary constituency;
- (b) the status of the projects taken up under Phase-I of the Bharatmala Pariyojana in Wayanad parliamentary constituency;
- (c) the details of the projects proposed to be taken up under the Bharatmala Pariyojana not covered in Phase-I in Wayanad parliamentary constituency;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to develop ropeways and alternate mobility solutions in Wayanad parliamentary constituency and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether the Government has received any proposal from the Government of Kerala for an alternate route/bypass for the Ghat section from Thamarassery to Kalpetta and if so, the details thereof and the status of the proposal?

#### ANSWER

## THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

(a) NH Corridor of NH 766 connecting Kozhikode to Kollagal (Mysore) is passing through Wayanad Parliamentary constituency in Kerala. Capacity augmentation to 2-lane with paved shoulders from km 40.00 (Puthupady) to Km 117.600 (Muthana) of NH-766 has been taken up for which Ministry has sanctioned Rs.214.88 Crore for Land Acquisition process. Greenfield alignment from Kerala/Karnataka Border (Kutta) to Purakkattiri (Kozhikode) has been finalised which is also passing through Wayanad Parliamentary constituency.

- (b) & (c) No proposals under Phase-I of the Bharatmala Pariyojana have been taken up in the Wayanad Parliamentary constituency.
- (d) Yes Sir, National Highways Logistics Management Limited (NHLML), 100% owned Company of NHAI has been mandated by MoRT&H for development of ropeways in the Country. NHLML has received one ropeway proposal from Adivaram to Lakidi in Wayanad Parliamentary constituency.
