BENEFICIAL WORKS UNDER AMRUT

NO. 788. SHRIMATI SANDHYA RAY

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of beneficial works done by the Union Government in Madhya Pradesh, particularly in Bhind and Datia districts under the AMRUT scheme during last four years, district and year-wise; and**
- (b) the details of total expenditure incurred under the AMRUT scheme in Madhya Pradesh, particularly in Bhind and Datia districts during the last four years, district and year-wise?**

(a): Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) was launched by the Central Government on June 25, 2015, for 500 cities (485 cities including 15 merged cities) across all States/ Union Territories (UTs) in the country. The mission is in its extended period till 31 March, 2024. The major thrust areas of the Mission are water supply, sewerage & septage management, storm water drainage, green spaces & parks, non-motorized urban transport and capacity building.

For the State of Madhya Pradesh, State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) amounting to ₹6,200.67 crore, including committed Central Assistance (CA) of ₹2,592.86 crore have been approved under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT). Under AMRUT, Madhya Pradesh State has taken up 216 projects worth ₹6,766 crore, of which 197 projects worth ₹4,507 crore have been completed, while 19 projects worth ₹2,259 crore have been grounded and are at various stages of implementation.

During the Mission period, for the city of Bhind, State Government has taken up and completed 4 projects costing ₹89.08 crore, which include 02 projects of development of Parks/ Green spaces costing ₹1.30 crore, 02 projects costing ₹84.16 crore and ₹3.62 crore in the sectors of Sewerage & Septage Management and Non-Motorized Urban Transport respectively.

For the city of Datia, State Government has taken up 02 projects costing ₹77.5 crore, of which 01 project of water supply project costing ₹18.66 crore have been completed and 01 Sewerage and Septage Management project worth ₹58.84 crore is under implementation.

The district-wise project details in Madhya Pradesh under AMRUT is at ANNEXURE.

(b): Under AMRUT, Central funds are allocated and released to the State as per the Mission guidelines and not city-wise or district –wise. For the State of Madhya Pradesh, CA of ₹2,592.86 crore has been allocated for the entire Mission period towards implementation of projects taken up under AMRUT. So far, CA amounting to ₹2,497.06 crore has been released to the Government of Madhya Pradesh for the implementation of the AMRUT projects against which the State has submitted 100% Utilization Certificates (UCs).

Further, as per the information available, ₹82.87 crore and ₹77.45 crore have been utilized for AMRUT projects by the city of Bhind and Datia respectively during the Mission period of AMRUT till date.
