VARIOUS SCHEMES FOR URBAN POOR

No. 820 SHRI B. B. PATIL:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- a) the details of various schemes being run by the Government for the urban poor;**
- b) the funds allocated and spent under the urban development schemes during the last five years, State-wise, especially in Telangana;**
- c) whether any skill training is being given to urban unemployed youth and if so, the number of youths trained and given placement, separately, in Telangana during the last three years; and**
- d) whether any monitoring mechanism is in place to oversee the funds allocated by the Government during this period with the cooperation of the State Government; and**
- e) if so, the details thereof and the action taken under such monitoring mechanism?**

ANSWER

- (a): Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs (MoHUA) is administering a Centrally Sponsored Scheme named “Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM)”, through the respective States/UTs, to reduce poverty and vulnerability of urban poor household by enabling them to**

access gainful self-employment and skilled wage employment opportunities, for improvement in their livelihoods on a sustainable basis. In addition, Prime Minister Street Vendors Atma Nirbhar Nidhi (PMSVANidhi) was launched on 1st June, 2020 with the objective of facilitating collateral free working capital loan upto Rs. 50,000/- to street vendors, incentivising regular repayments and rewarding digital transaction.

- (b) State-wise details of funds released and utilised under DAY-NULM for the last five years, including the details for Telangana as well, are attached at Annexure-I.**
- (c) Skill training is imparted under Employment through Skills Training & Placement (EST&P) component of DAY-NULM. As per information received from State of Telangana, 592 youths have been trained during the last three years.**
- (d)&(e) DAY-NULM Management Information System Portal and Public Financial Management System (PFMS) are the monitoring mechanism to oversee the funds allocated by the Government with the cooperation of the State Governments. Review Meetings through Video Conferencing/ Field visits are undertaken on regular basis to monitor the physical progress as well as utilisation of funds.**
