WATER SCHEMES IN HARYANA

832. SHRI NAYAB SINGH:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the schemes being implemented by the Ministry to facilitate the rural population in Kurukshetra Parliamentary Constituency;

(b) the details of the various schemes that are being implemented across the State to tackle the problem of water scarcity;

(c) the funds allocated and utilised for those schemes in Haryana;

(d) whether the Government proposes to implement any special water scheme in various districts of Haryana having water scarcity; and

(e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (e) Since August, 2019, Government of India is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) in partnership with States to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household of the country, including in Haryana.

At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission in August 2019, 17.66 Lakh (58.08%) rural households in Haryana were reported to have tap water connections. Since then, 12.75 Lakh additional rural households were provided with tap water connections in the State. As on date, all 30.41 Lakhs rural households in the State, are reported to have covered with tap water supply. Similarly, in Kurukshetra district of the State, at launch of JJM, 83,047 (59.44%) rural households were reported to have tap water connections. Since then, 56,673 additional rural households were provided with tap water connections in the district covering all rural households with tap water supply in the district.

Under the mission, provisions have been made for source recharging, viz. dedicated bore well recharge structures, rainwater recharge, rejuvenation of existing water bodies, reuse of greywater, etc., in convergence with other schemes such as MGNREGS, Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP), 15th Finance Commission tied grants to RLBs/ PRIs, State schemes, CSR funds, etc.

Under the JJM, the details of funds allocated and utilized in the state of Haryana, are as under:
