**MONUMENT MITRA SCHEME**

**85. SHRI KANUMURU RAGHU RAMA KRISHNA RAJU:**

**Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:**

- (a) Whether the Government has introduced the Monument Mitra Scheme to adopt heritage sites and maintain them to enable private firms to become partners in upkeeping about one thousand ASI monuments in the country under the revamped Monument Mitra scheme; and**
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the present status thereof, State-wise?**

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER OF TOURISM**

**(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)**

**(a): Yes, Sir. The 'Adopt a Heritage: Apni Dhरोhar, Apni Pehchan' was initially launched on 27.09.2017 by the Ministry of Tourism, in collaboration with the Ministry of Culture and Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) and various States/UTs Governments wherein the entities, called Monument Mitras were permitted to engage in activities in order to provide and maintain basic tourist amenities. Now, a revamped version of the program exclusively for Centrally Protected Monuments (CPMs) is envisioned wherein ASI envisages creating a framework for engaging with the private/public sector companies to develop/provide group of amenities at CPMs through CSR funds to enhance visitor's experience with a view to make them visitor friendly. This revamped version titled "Adopt A Heritage Program 2.0" was launched on 04.09.2023 by the Union Minister of Culture wherein the entities, now called Smaraka Saarathi and Smaraka Saathi for that matter according to the nature of their participation, are permitted to engage in non-conservational activities viz., cleaning of monument premises, besides to provide and maintain basic tourist amenities like washroom, drinking water, child care room, benches, pathways, garbage bins, signage, SeL shows, illumination, etc. under the guidance and due consultation with ASI.**

**(b): The entire process of identification, application and adoption of CPMs as well as selection of these entities became completely online through a dedicated portal maintaining the utmost fairness and transparency. However, the work related to archaeological conservation and preservation of CPMs was exclusively attended by the experts of ASI only under their own allotted budget. State-wise list of 23 MoUs signed under Adopt a Heritage Project for monuments/sites under the jurisdiction of Archaeological Survey of India with various Monument Mitras, transferred by Ministry of Tourism to Ministry of Culture is at Annexure.**
