(a) to (d) : Government of India launched Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. Puducherry was selected for development as a Smart City in Round-3 of the selection process held in June 2017. The status of projects of Puducherry Smart City is given below:
