MINI-ANGANWADI CENTRES

936. SHRI GAJANAN KIRTIKAR: SHRI KRUPAL BALAJI TUMANE:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of Mini-Anganwadi Centres (Mini-AWCs) in the country and the facilities made available there in, State-wise including Maharashtra, district-wise especially in Ramtek-Nagpur Parliamentary Constituency;
- (b) whether any criterion of population has been fixed for the setting up of Mini-AWCs, if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) whether the honorarium of Anganwadi Workers engaged in Mini-AWCs has been increased;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (e) whether proposals for the setting up of Mini-AWCs have been received from Maharashtra State, if so, the details thereof along with the action taken in this regard; and
- (f) whether the Government proposes to allocate additional funds for the upgradation of such centres and the construction of their permanent buildings, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) The State/UT-wise statement of sanctioned Mini Anganwadi Centres (AWCs) across the country including State of Maharashtra is at **Annexure-A**. The Government has taken a policy decision to upgrade all Mini-AWCs to Main Anganwadi Centres. Out of 1,16,852 Mini-AWCs sanctioned for 23 States/UTs, orders have been issued for upgradation of 42,268 Mini-AWCs in 12 States/UTs. The facilities made available at Anganwadi Centres (including mini-AWCs) is as under:
 - i. Supplementary Nutrition (SNP)
 - ii. Pre-school Non-formal Education,

- iii. Nutrition & Health Education,
- iv. Immunization,
- v. Health Check-up, and
- vi. Referral Services

Three of the six services, viz., Immunization, Health check-up and Referral Services are related to health and are provided through NHM & Public Health Infrastructure. The services are provided to all eligible beneficiaries namely children in the age group of 0-6 years, pregnant women and lactating mothers through the platform of Anganwadi Centres across the country. The district-wise details of mini Anganwadi Centres in the State of Maharashtra is at **Annexure-B**.

The details of Mini-Anganwadi Centres (Mini AWCs) in Ramtek-Nagpur

- (c) & (d) From 1st October, 2018, Government of India has enhanced the honorarium of AWWs at mini- AWCs from Rs.2,250/- to Rs.3,500/- per month and introduced performance linked incentive of Rs.500 to AWWs. In addition, States/UTs are also paying additional monetary incentives/honorarium to these functionaries from their own resources which vary from State to State. In view of the decision to upgrade all Mini AWCs to Main AWC, the honoranium of AWWs in upgraded Mini AWCs would be same as Main AWW.
- (e) A total of 13011 Mini Anganwadi Centres are sanctioned for the State of Maharashtra. The approval for upgradation of a total of 13011 Mini Anganwadi Centres to Main Anganwadi Centres has been given to the State of Maharashtra.
- (f) For upgradation of all Anganwadi Centres (including Mini Anganwadi Centres), various steps have been under taken including the following:

Under Saksham Anganwadi, 2 lakh AWCs @ 40,000 AWCs per year shall be strengthened, upgraded and rejuvenated across the country for improved nutrition

delivery and for early childhood care and development. A total of Rs.21273.63 Lakh has been released in FY 2022-23 under this initiative.

For construction of Anganwadi Centres in convergence with MGNREGS, construction cost has been revised from Rs.7 lakh to Rs.12 lakh per unit. The cost of drinking water facilities and toilets at Anganwadi Centres have been increased from Rs.10,000/- to Rs.17,000/- and Rs.12,000/- to Rs.36,000/- respectively.

In convergence with Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation, clean drinking water is provided to Anganwadi Centres through pipelines.
