#### HEALTH PROTECTION SCHEME

### 964. SHRI VELUSAMY P: SHRI PARTHIBAN S.R:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is implementing the largest public funded health protection scheme in the world;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise including district-wise for Tamil Nadu; and
- (c) the details of the eligible beneficiaries under the Scheme, State/UT-wise including district-wise for the State of Tamil Nadu?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (PROF. S. P. SINGH BAGHEL)

(a) to (c): Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri - Jan Arogya Yojana (AB PM-JAY) is the largest publicly funded health assurance scheme in the world which aims to provide health cover of Rs. 5 lakhs per family per year for secondary and tertiary care hospitalization to 12 Crore families. AB PM-JAY is being implemented in 33 States and Union Territories (UTs) except for Delhi, Odisha, and West Bengal. Approximately 27.8 Crore Ayushman Cards have been created. Further, 6 Crore hospital admissions worth Rs. 77,298 Crores have been authorized under the scheme. The Statewise details of eligible families is enclosed as **Annexure-I**.

In the State of Tamil Nadu, Ayushman Bharat PM-JAY is being implemented in convergence with State specific scheme Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme (CMCHIS). A total of 1.46 Crore families are eligible for healthcare benefits under the integrated scheme, of which 86.48 Lakh families are supported by Central and State Governments and an additional 59.82 Lakh families are supported exclusively by the State Government. As of 2nd December 2023, approximately 53.63 Lakh Ayushman Cards have been created. Further, 96.25 Lakh hospital admissions worth Rs. 6143.4 Crores have been authorized under the scheme in the State. The district wise details of eligible families in the State of Tamil Nadu is enclosed as **Annexure – II**.
