SUPER SPECIALITY HOSPITAL IN BHAGALPUR

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state: -

- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up super speciality hospitals in Bhagalpur Parliamentary constituency and if so, the details thereof along with the time by which it is likely to be made operational;
- (b) the quality and the safety standards adopted for setting up of said/such hospitals;
- (c) whether any quality inspection has been proposed after the completion of the construction of said/such hospitals building; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (d) Under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), upgradation of Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College & Hospital, Bhagalpur by way of setting up a Super Speciality Block (SSB) was sanctioned in Phase-IV of PMSSY in 2016 at a total approved cost of Rs 200 Crore, on cost sharing basis, in the ratio of 60:40 between Centre and State respectively. The Super Speciality Block has Nephrology, Cardiology, Neurology, Neurosurgery, Urology, Cardiothoracic Surgery, Trauma and Emergency Departments. The civil work has been completed by CPWD. The quality and safety standard adopted is as per CPWD specifications and provisions of National Building Code. The inspection regarding quality of work has been conducted during execution and at the completion stage by CPWD Officers. In addition external Third Party Inspection was conducted by the technical team of Jadavpur University, Kolkata.
