REDUCTION OF CONTRIBUTION IN ESI

†98. SHRI RAMCHARAN BOHRA:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)whether the Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) has reduced the Employees' State Insurance (ESI) contributions made by employees and employers;
- (b)if so, the number of employers benefited from this move;
- (c)whether the healthcare benefits under the scheme have been changed after reduction in the contribution rate; and (d)if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) to (d): Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) has reduced the contribution rates w.e.f 01.07.2019 from 6.5% to 4% (employers' contribution reduced from 4.75% to 3.25% and employees' contribution reduced from 1.75% to 0.75%).

All the employers covered under the ESIC benefited due to reduction in rate of contribution, as below:

2019-20	-	12,36,565
2020-21	-	14,82,125
2021-22	-	15,94,083
2022-23	-	20,83,340

ESI Corporation has not changed any health care benefits under the ESI scheme after change in the contribution rate.
