Setting up of AYUSH Centres in Madhya Pradesh

*20. SHRI GYANESHWAR PATIL:

Will the Minister of AYUSH be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the completed and proposed AYUSH centres in Madhya Pradesh during the last three years and the current year, district-wise;
- (b) the funds sanctioned by the Government for the proposed AYUSH centres in Madhya Pradesh;
- (c) whether the Government has fixed any time-limit for completion of all the proposed AYUSH centres in Madhya Pradesh; and
- (d)if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d)A Statement is laid on the Table of the House.

The Statement referred to in reply to Lok Sabha Starred Question No. 20 for 2^{nd} February, 2024

(a) to (d) Public Health being a State subject, establishment of AYUSH centres in the country including Madhya Pradesh comes under the purview of respective State/UT Governments. However, under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM), there is a provision of financial assistance for setting up of 50/30/10 bedded integrated Ayush Hospitals in the country including Madhya Pradesh. As per the proposals received from the State Government of Madhya Pradesh through State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs), the Ministry of Ayush has approved 10 integrated Ayush hospitals in Madhya Pradesh. The district-wise status of sanctioned funds for these approved integrated Ayush hospitals along with their status of progress during last three years and current year is furnished at **Annexure**. However, implementation of the Scheme comes under the purview of the respective State Government and accordingly timeline has not been fixed by the Government of India.
