- (a) the allocation and utilization of funds released to States/UTs for enhancing the food processing sector, detailing the schemes and projects supported in each State/UT for the fiscal years 2018-19 to 2022-23;
- (b) the details of credit-linked financial assistance provided to entrepreneurs for setting up food processing/preservation industries during the same period; and
- (c) the number of beneficiaries of the above and the total amount disbursed so far?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. *52 FOR ANSWER ON 06TH FEBRUARY, 2024 REGARDING "FUNDS FOR ENHANCEMENT OF FOOD PROCESSING SECTOR"

(a): Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) has been incentivizing setting up/expansion of related infrastructure through its Central Sector Umbrella Scheme Pradhan Mantri Kisan SAMPADA Yojana (PMKSY) since 2016-17, Production Linked Incentive Scheme for Food Processing Industry (PLISFPI) since 2021-22 and Centrally sponsored PM Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PMFME) scheme since 2020-21.

Under component schemes of PMKSY, MoFPI provides mostly financial assistance to entrepreneurs with total outlay of Rs 10600 Cr for 14th & 15th Finance Commission Cycle. PMKSY is not region or state specific but demand driven with no state-wise fund allocation & release.

PLISFPI is, inter alia, intended to support creation of global food manufacturing champions and support Indian brands of food products in international market. The Scheme is being implemented over a six-year period from 2021-22 to 2026-27 with an outlay of Rs. 10,900 crores and a total of 173 food processing companies have been approved for assistance under various categories of the scheme.

Ministry also provides financial, technical and business support for setting up/ upgradation of micro food processing enterprises under PMFME scheme. The scheme is operational for a period of five years from 2020-21 to 2024-25 with total outlay of Rs 10,000 Crore.

The Year-wise details of funds allocated and funds utilized in the schemes of Ministry is placed at **Annexure-I**. Funds released to States/UTs under PMFME scheme is placed at **Annexure-II**. State-wise Food Processing Projects sanctioned under schemes of MoFPI is placed at **Annexure-III**.

(b) & (c): Ministry has approved 1390 projects including 41 Mega food Parks, 372 Cold Chain projects, 70 Agro- Processing Clusters, 505 Food Processing Units, 61 Creation of Backward & Forward Linkages Projects & 53 Operation Green projects under corresponding component schemes of PMKSY since inception, with total released/ disbursed subsidy of Rs 5453.43 Cr. Under PMFME Scheme, a total of 72840 micro food processing enterprises have been approved for assistance till date, with total released/ disbursed credit linked subsidy of Rs 779.28 Cr.
