## Statement in reply to lok sabha starred question no. \*78 for answer on 07.02.2024 by SHRI BASANTA KUMAR PANDA regarding "Financial Assistance to Odisha".

- (a): Government is implementing a number of schemes for the development of textile sector across the country including Odisha. The allocation of funds is done scheme-wise and not State-wise and Districtwise. The details of expenditure in the major schemes on pan-India basis during last 9 years are at **ANNEXURE.**
- (b) & (c): The Government is implementing various initiatives/schemes such as National Handicrafts Development Programme, Comprehensive Handicrafts Development Scheme, National Handloom Development Programme and Raw Material Supply scheme to provide end-to-end support to weavers and artisans on pan-India basis including the State of Odisha. The benefits under Direct Benefit Transfer have been provided to 3,11,482 weavers under Handloom sector and 26,642 artisans in Handicrafts sector in Odisha during last 9 years and current year.
- (d): Presently no project/proposal from Odisha is pending with the Government.
