## INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS FROM LUCKNOW AIRPORT

## \*88. SHRI RITESH PANDEY

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION नागर विमानन मंत्री

be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government has prepared any action plan to improve the connectivity of international flights from Lucknow Airport in Uttar Pradesh to ensure direct connectivity to the US, UK and other countries;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government also plans to expand runways and taxiways to accommodate aircrafts directly connecting Lucknow to the US and UK; and (d) if so, the details of tender issued and progress achieved with regard to land acquisition along with the expected timeline for completion of the project?

## **ANSWER**

(a) to (d): A statement is laid on the table of the House.

Statement referred in reply to Part (a) to (d) of Lok Sabha Starred Question No. 88 regarding "International Flights from Lucknow Airport" to be answered on 08.02.2024.

- (a) & (b): Presently, Lucknow is directly connected to countries such as UAE, Saudi Arabia, Oman and Thailand. The international operations of airlines are governed by the bilateral Air Services Agreement (ASA) between India and the respective country. In order to improve international air connectivity from Lucknow, it has been included in the list of 18 tourist destinations which are available to designated carriers of ASEAN and SAARC countries (except Pakistan & Afghanistan) for unlimited operations. Lucknow is also available as a point of call for designated carriers of USA and UK. However, start of direct international flights from any point in India is purely a commercial decision of scheduled airlines on the basis of passenger demand, availability of slots, economic viability of the route and other associated factors.
- (c) & (d): Upgradation/expansion of airports is a continuous process and is undertaken by Airports Authority of India (AAI) and other Airport Operators from time to time depending on the availability of land, commercial viability, socio-economic considerations, traffic demand / willingness of airlines to operate to/from such airports. AAI has leased out Lucknow airport under Public Private Partnership (PPP) for operation, management and development on long term lease basis. The PPP partner has embarked upon the airport expansion plan which also includes extension of runway and construction of taxiways. However, the timeline for completion of the airport projects depends upon many factors such as land acquisition, availability of mandatory clearances, financial closure etc.
