STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 91 ANSWERED ON 08<sup>™</sup> FEBRUARY, 2024 ASKED BY SHRI VE. VAITHILINGAM REGARDING 'ELEVATED CORRIDOR':

(a) to (c) Consultancy for preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) of the proposed flyover connecting Indira Gandhi Square and Rajiv Gandhi Square was awarded through PWD, Union Territory (UT) of Puducherry in July, 2022 on the request of then Hon'ble Chief Minister of Puducherry. Draft DPR has been submitted by the consultant.

The stretch is presently under maintenance by National Highways Authority of India (NHAI). NHAI has conducted a study which has recommended construction of a bypass from Kalapettai on NH 332A (East Costal Road) crossing this stretch at km 13/300 of old NH 66 (New NH-32) and joining at km 24/800 of Old NH 45A (NH 332), bypassing the stretch connecting Indira Gandhi Square and Rajiv Gandhi Square on old NH 66 for through traffic from Mamallapuram towards Villupuram, Cuddalore & other places.
