**STATUS OF AMRUT SCHEME IN MISRIKH  
NO. 1134. SHRI ASHOK KUMAR RAWAT:**

**Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details and the current status of the work being done under the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) scheme in the country particularly in Misrikh Parliamentary Constituency of Uttar Pradesh; and**
- (b) the details of the central funds allocated and utilized in this regard during the last three years till date, year and State-wise?**

**(a): Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) was launched on 25 June 2015 in selected 500 cities (485 cities including 15 merged cities) and towns across the country. The Mission focuses on development of basic infrastructure, in the selected cities and towns, in the sectors of water supply; sewerage and septage management; storm water drainage; green spaces and parks; and non-motorized urban transport.**

**Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has approved State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) of all the States/Union Territories (UTs) amounting to ₹77,640 crore for the entire Mission period, which includes committed Central Assistance (CA) of ₹35,990 crore. So far, States/UTs have grounded 5,901 projects worth ₹82,958 crore, of which ₹75,571 crore have been physically completed and expenditure of ₹68,458 crore has been incurred.**

**In Uttar Pradesh, 60 cities are taken up under AMRUT, State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) worth ₹11,421.67 crore have been approved including central share of ₹4,922.46 crore. As reported by State, in Misrikh Parliamentary Constituency, there is no AMRUT city. However, under AMRUT 2.0, one water supply project titled "Nagar Palika Parisad Mishrikh-Neemsar Reorganization water supply scheme" worth ₹22.33 crore have been approved for the ULB Misrikh cum Neemsar in the Sitapur District of Uttar Pradesh.**

**(b): Under AMRUT, Central funds are allocated at the start of the Mission and not year-wise. State-wise funds released and utilized during the last 3 years under AMRUT is attached as ANNEXURE.**
