PUBLIC PROCUREMENT POLICY FOR MSEs

1141. SHRI GYANESHWAR PATIL:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the significance of the public procurement policy for the Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs);
- (b) the manner in which the same has impacted procurements from MSEs by the Central Ministries/Departments/Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs); and
- (c) the details of the total procurement made from MSEs by the Central Ministries/Department/ CPSEs ?

(a) & (b): With the objective of promoting the growth and development of MSMEs by improving their market access and linkages and providing an assured market, the Ministry of MSME notified the implementation of the Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order from 1st April, 2012. The Policy is notified under the MSMED Act 2006. The Policy was made mandatory from 1st April 2015 and amended in 2018. The amended policy mandates 25% annual procurement from MSEs by Central Ministries/ Departments/ Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs), including 4% from MSEs owned by SC/ST and 3% from MSEs owned by Women entrepreneurs.

(c): The total procurement by Central Ministries/ Departments/CPSEs from MSEs during the financial year 2023-24 (upto 05.02.2024) is Rs. 45,763.21 crores.
