#### MANDATORY HEALTH INSURANCE

#### **1183.** SHRI KUNWAR PUSHPENDRA SINGH CHANDEL:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government proposes to make health insurance mandatory for all the citizens in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the details of the health insurance coverage in the country, State/UT-wise including Bundelkhand;

(d) whether the Government is making any efforts so that people aged above 70 years may get health insurance easily; and

(e) if so, the details thereof?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (PROF. S. P. SINGH BAGHEL)

(a) to (e): Ayushman Bharat – Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) is the world's largest publicly funded health assurance scheme which provides health cover of Rs. 5 lakh per family per year for secondary and tertiary care hospitalization to approximately 55 crore beneficiaries corresponding to 12 crore families constituting the bottom 40% of India's population. States/UTs implementing AB-PMJAY have further expanded the beneficiary base, at their own cost. State/UT-wise details of eligible families under the scheme are at **Annexure-I**.

Bundelkhand region of India comprises of seven districts of Uttar Pradesh and six districts of Madhya Pradesh. Details of eligible families under the scheme in Bundelkhand region are at **Annexure-II**.

Since all members of an eligible family are entitled for healthcare cover under AB-PMJAY, senior citizens in such eligible families are also covered under the scheme.
