- (a) whether the Government has any data regarding the number of people who renounced their Indian Citizenship and took up other foreign citizenships during the last three years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has maintained data of State-wise distribution of people who renounced Indian citizenship for other foreign citizenships; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI V. MURALEEDHARAN)

(a to d) As per the information available with the Ministry, the number of Indians who renounced their Indian citizenship was 1,63,370 (in 2021); 2,25,620 (in 2022) and 2,16,219 (in 2023). For reference purpose, data was 1,22,819 (in 2011); 1,20,923 (in 2012); 1,31,405 (in 2013); 1,29,328 (in 2014); 1,31,489 (in 2015); 1,41,603 (in 2016); 1,33,049 (in 2017); 1,34,561 (in 2018); 1,44,017 (in 2019); 85,256 (in 2020). State-wise distribution of people who renounced Indian citizenship for other foreign citizenships is not available.
