1273. DR. PON GAUTHAM SIGAMANI:

Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has signed a contract for procurement of six next generation offshore patrol vessels for the Coast Guard;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Coast Guard proposes to replace many ageing vessels used for patroling and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether it is a fact that such vessels are proposed to be equipped with multipurpose drones and AI capability; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) & (b): Yes, Sir. Ministry of Defence has signed a Contract with Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Ltd. (MDL) Mumbai on 20th December, 2023 for procurement of six Next Generation Offshore Patrol Vessels (NGOPVs) for Indian Coast Guard (ICG) under the Buy (Indian IDDM) category at a total cost of Rs.1614.89 Crore.
- (c): The ageing vessels are replaced on completion of their designed life and based on the analysis of hull/machinery conditions.
- (d) & (e): Multipurpose drones & AI are among the advanced equipment for the NGOPVs as per the contract. The equipment procurement is carried out by the contracted shipyard.
