SEAT-LEAVING BOND POLICY IN MEDICAL COLLEGES

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government intends to revoke the seat-leaving bond policy in medical colleges in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government/National Medical Commission (NMC) has received reports from concerned students being harassed and made to pay hefty sums of money by medical college authorities leading to depression/anxiety issues in students desirous of leaving their course; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the details of higher number of cases of discontinuation of courses during the last three academic years in the country, State/UT-wise?

(a) to (d) National Medical Commission (NMC) has requested State Governments to review the seat leaving bond policy in Medical Colleges in the concerned States. As regard details of discontinuation of courses during the last three academic years in the country, State/UT-wise, it is informed that the same is not maintained centrally.
