"IMPROVEMENT IN INFRASTRUCTURE OF ANGANWADIS"

148 SHRI JAGANNATH SARKAR:

- Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:
- (a) the details of the beneficiaries of Supplementary Nutrition Programme (SNP) under POSHAN 2.0 in aspirational districts, particularly in West Bengal, since the launch of the scheme;
- (b) whether any steps have been taken to improve infrastructure of Anganwadis in the country under Saksham Anganwadi Scheme; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof, State-wise particularly in West Bengal?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) As per the data available on Poshan Tracker for the month of December 2023, 48,78,798 beneficiaries are covered in Supplementary Nutrition Programme under Mission Poshan 2.0 in 112 Aspirational Districts of the country. West Bengal has not participated in Aspirational Districts Programme. However, 84,12,620 beneficiaries (Children between 6 months 6 years, Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers) are registered under Mission Poshan 2.0 in the State of West Bengal.
- (b) and (c) Under Saksham Anganwadi, 2 lakh Anganwadi Centres @ 40,000 AWCs per year are being upgraded as Saksham Anganwadis which have better infrastructure than the conventional Anganwadi Centres including LED screens, water purifier/RO Machine and equipped with smart learning, audio-visual aids and internet/Wi-Fi connectivity wherever feasible. The State/UT wise number of AWCs approved under Saksham Anganwadi during FY 2022-23, including the State of West Bengal is at **Annexure I**.
