AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF PMNDP

221. SHRI SANJAY SETH:

Will the MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the aims, objectives and salient features of the Prime Minister's National Dialysis Programme (PMNDP) in the country;
- (b) whether the Prime Minister National Dialysis Programme has been implemented in the State of Jharkhand and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of the funds spent on patients who are suffering from kidney disease under the said scheme;
- (d) the number of beneficiaries who have been benefitted under the said scheme, district-wise; and
- (e) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to increase the number of dialysis machines and implement the said scheme effectively?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (PROF. SATYA PAL SINGH BAGHEL)

(a) to (e) Pradhan Mantri National Dialysis Programme (PMNDP) for Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD) patients ensures availability of dialysis services in all the district hospitals in the country free of cost to all Below Poverty Line (BPL) beneficiaries. The objective of the program is to improve access to hemodialysis (HD) by setting up one dialysis centre in each district hospital in the country. Peritoneal dialysis was also included 2020 onwards. Pradhan Mantri National Dialysis Programme (PMNDP) portal is developed with the objective to build renal registries in the States/UTs with portability of dialysis services under the 'One Nation-One Dialysis' concept. The portal is operational across the States in the country.

PMNDP has been implemented in Jharkhand (in PPP mode) and is operational in all 24 districts at 24 dialysis centers by deploying 88 hemodialysis machines. Total 14701 beneficiaries availed dialysis services in Jharkhand.

The expenditure incurred under Pradhan Mantri National Dialysis Programme under National Health Mission (NHM) in Jharkhand during the FY 2022-23 is Rs 324.04 lakhs.
