INCREASE IN UNEMPLOYMENT AND REDUCTION IN JOBS IN VARIOUS SECTORS

246. SHRI RAMSHIROMANI VERMA:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there has been a huge increase in the number of unemployed persons registered in the country during the last three years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government has conducted any survey regarding the reduction in jobs in various sectors during the last three years; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) to (d): The data on Employment and Unemployment is collected through Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) which is conducted by the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MoSPI) since 2017-18. The survey period is July to June every year.

As per the latest available Annual PLFS Reports, the estimated Unemployment Rate (UR) on usual status for persons of age 15 years and above was 4.2%, 4.1% and 3.2% during 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23, respectively. The data indicates that the unemployment rate in the country has a declining trend over the years.

As per the latest available Annual PLFS Reports, the estimated Worker Population Ratio (WPR) on usual status for persons of age 15 years and above was 52.6%, 52.9% and 56.0% during 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23, respectively, which indicates that the worker population ratio, indicating employment, has an increasing trend over the years.

The estimated percentage distribution of workers on usual status by broad industry division during 2020-21 to 2022-23 is given at Annexure.
