Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number and details of accounts opened under the Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY) in Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra, Andaman and Nicobar, Assam and Odisha, during each of the last three years and the current year, district-wise;
- (b) whether many of accounts started under PMJDY has become inoperative and if so, the reasons for constant decline in operational accounts and the corrective steps taken by the Government in this regard;
- (c) the details of the number of RuPay cards issued so far under this Yojana to the beneficiaries especially women in Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra, Andaman and Nicobar, Assam and Odisha;
- (d) whether Government has given top priority to last mile banking services under this Yojana;
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the advance steps being taken by the Government to connect remote areas with banking/digital banking; and
- (f) the efforts made by the Government to increase the number of branches of Public Sector Banks in rural areas to make PMJDY more successful?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE

(a) to (c) Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY) was launched in August 2014 and was further extended beyond 14.08.2018. The details of the number of PMJDY accounts of Public Sector Banks and major Private Sector Banks in Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra, Andaman and Nicobar, Assam and Odisha, at the end of last three financial years and as on 17.01.2024 of current financial year, district-wise is Annexed. The details of number of RuPay Cards issued to PMJDY beneficiaries are as under:

As per Reserve Bank of India guidelines, a savings as well as current account should be treated as inoperative/ dormant, if there are no customer induced transactions in the account for over a period of two years.

Banks are making concerted efforts to reduce the percentage of inoperative accounts and the progress is being regularly monitored by the Government. Banks also organise camps at local level to create awareness about good banking habits including the benefits of keeping the account active/ operative. As a result of various initiatives, the percentage of inoperative PMJDY accounts has come down from 40% in March'17 to 20.6 % in January'24.

(d) to (f) Government's endeavour is to connect every inhabited village with banking outlet (bank branch / Business Correspondent (BC) / India Post Payments Banks (IPPB) branch) within 5 km radius. Government has launched a Geographic Information System (GIS) based App., namely, Jan Dhan Darshak (JDD) App to monitor the coverage of village with banking services. Out of 6,01,328 inhabited villages mapped on Jan Dhan Darshak App, 99.81% villages are covered by a banking outlet through 1.73 lakh Branches, 9.80 lakh BCs, and 1.62 lakh IPPB. Banks are also adopting latest digital technologies to provide their customers with the enhanced and hassle-free banking services in a digital mode.

Apart from these, 96 Digital Banking Units (DBUs) have been set up by Banks in 93 districts covering all States and UTs across the country. Further, banks, with their strong network of BCs, are providing hassle free services to the customers in remote / tribal areas.

As per extant guidelines dated 18.5.2017 on rationalisation of Branch Authorisation Policy, Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has granted general permission to domestic Scheduled Commercial Banks (excluding Regional Rural Banks), to open banking outlets at any place in the country, without seeking prior approval of RBI in each case, subject to at least 25 percent of the total number of banking outlets opened during a financial year being in unbanked rural centres i.e. centres having population less than 10,000 (Tier 5 and Tier 6 centres).
