TRAINING TO YOUTH UNDER DDU-GKY

**489. SHRI MANOJ TIWARI:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) is being implemented by the Government in the Country and if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Haryana;**
- (b) the modes of training being provided to youths under DDU-GKY, State and district-wise particularly in the State of Bihar and Jharkhand;**
- (c) whether under the said yojana, training is being provided to the youth in rural areas in Rohtak district, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons for the same;**
- (d) whether any special education project has also been prepared for them in this regard and if so, the details thereof;**
- (e) whether the Government has taken any steps to provide employment to such youths after the completion of said training programme and if so, the details thereof;**
- (f) whether any financial benefits are being provided to the rural youths; and**
- (g) if so, the number of beneficiaries State and district-wise?**

**ANSWER
MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT

(a) Yes, Deen Dayal Upadhyaya-Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) is being implemented as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme under National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM) since the year 2014-15. The State-wise details for the scheme including Haryana are given at Annexure-I.

(b) The training being imparted to the youth under DDU-GKY, country-wide (including Bihar and Jharkhand), is based on the qualification packs approved by the National Skills Qualification Committee. The training consists of theory, practical and On-the Job training (OJT) imparted in domain skills, computer skills, soft skills and English skills

(c) Rural Poor youth in the state of Haryana (including the district Rohtak) are eligible for training under DDU-GKY. Targets under DDU-GKY are approved State-wise while District-wise beneficiary details are not maintained centrally.

(d) No special education project has been formulated under DDU-GKY.

(e) Under DDU-GKY, placement of the trained candidate is to be arranged by Project Implementation Agencies (PIAs). All payments to the PIAs are linked to achieving the outcome of the programme i.e. the placement of trained candidate. DDU-GKY scheme guidelines mandate a minimum of 70% placement of total trained candidates. Further, job fairs and employer meets are also organised by State Rural Livelihood Missions & State Skill Development Missions implementing DDU-GKY in the State for facilitating placement. The details of candidates trained and placed under DDU-GKY is provided at Annexure-I.

(f) DDU-GKY guidelines provide the candidates, other than Training Cost & Assessment Costs, the financial benefits such as Boarding & Lodging for Residential Trainees, Post Placement Support, Uniform, Food & Transport for Non Residential Trainees, Travel Support, Retention Support, Career Progression Support, Counselling support including medical checkups for candidates placed in foreign countries and Mobile top-up support @ Rs. 50 per month for a period of 12 months is also permissible within the Scheme for mobile tracking of the trainee.

(g) The State-wise beneficiaries details under the scheme are given at Annexure-I. District-wise beneficiary details are not maintained centrally.
