AWARENESS CAMPAIGN FOR WOMEN LED SHGs

**520. SHRI OMPRAKASH BHUPALSINH ALIAS PAWAN

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Women Self Help Groups (SHGs) registered in the country, State, district and village-wise particularly in Osmanabad in Maharashtra;**
- (b) whether the Government has launched any educational or awareness campaign for the said women led Self Help Groups (SHGs) to enhance their professional and operational knowledge and if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) the total funds disbursed for the schemes making special provision for the women entrepreneurs from the Self Help Groups (SHGs) in the country, State and district-wise, particularly in Rajasthan; and**
- (d) whether the Government proposes to launch any mentorship programme for these Self Help Groups (SHGs) in collaboration with the Institutes of National Importance and other Government Universities, if so, the details thereof?**

**ANSWER

- (a) A total of 90.39 lakh Women Self Help Groups (SHGs) have been mobilised under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana–National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM) and 6,35,183 SHGs have been mobilised in the State of Maharashtra. 14,686 SHGs have been mobilised in the Osmanabad District of Maharashtra, till 31st January 2024. The district wise details of SHGs in the State of Maharashtra is**

given at Annexure I. The village wise details of SHGs mobilised in Osmanabad District of Maharashtra may be seen at Monitoring Information System (MIS) link of the DAY-NRLM website:-

(b) A total of 28 types of special trainings are being conducted as per NRLM guidelines viz., basic training for SHGs, Village Organisations (VOs), Cluster Level Federations (CLFs), Gender training for community cadres and staff, Community auditors' training, Governance, Financial management, Visioning & Business Development Plan Training for Model CLFs etc. for enhancing their capabilities and knowledge in business.

(c) Start-up Village Entrepreneurship Programme (SVEP), a sub-scheme under DAY-NRLM has the objective of facilitating SHG members or their family members to set-up small enterprises in the non-farm sector. SVEP is demand based and there is no specific allocation for any State/UT. States/UTs submit the supplementary Annual Action Plan (AAP) for approval of SVEP Blocks. These AAPs are evaluated as per the scheme guidelines and presented to Empowered Committee (EC) for consideration and approval.

The details of funds released year-wise to States/UTs including Rajasthan under SVEP scheme are given in Annexure-II. In the State of Rajasthan, SVEP scheme has been approved in eighteen blocks, the details of which are at Annexure III.

(d) No, Sir. At present, there is no proposal to launch any mentorship programmes for the said SHGs in collaboration with Institutes of National Importance and other Government Universities.
