Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING मत्स्यपालन, पशुपालन और डेयरी मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that there is a huge shortage of veterinary colleges in proportion to the number of animals in the country including Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of veterinary colleges required in the country, State-wise including Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal;
- (d) the details of the ratio of animals to veterinary doctors in the country, State-wise including Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal;
- (e) the details of the criteria prescribed for opening of new veterinary colleges in Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal, district-wise including North and South Dinajpur districts of West Bengal; and
- (f) whether the Government has any proposal to bring about reforms in the veterinary colleges in the private sector and if so, the details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

## THE MINISTER FOR FISHERIES ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING (SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

- (a) & (b)Theestablishment of new veterinary colleges is a State subject. The State of Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal has five and one recognized veterinary colleges respectively.
- (c) The establishment of veterinary colleges is a state subject Hence, the requirement of number of veterinary colleges is decided by the respective State Government. The Veterinary Council of India is constituted under IVC Act. 1984 to regulate Veterinary practice as per the provision of Veterinary council of India (Procedure for recognition and de-recognition of Veterinary colleges and Veterinary qualification) Rules, 2017 and the central Government after constituting the council recognizes the

veterinary colleges The state wise details of approved veterinary college across India is enclosed at **Annexure-I.** 

- (d) As per the Indian Veterinary Practitioners Register 2023, there are 83017 numbers of Registered Veterinary Practitioners (RVPs) in the country. Out of this, there are 7107 RVPs in the State of Uttar Pradesh and 2661 in the State of West Bengal. The state-wise details of ratio of animals to veterinary doctors in the country is attached at **Annexure-II.**
- (e) The criteria for establishment of veterinary colleges across the country is based on VCI (Procedure for recognition and de-recognition of Veterinary colleges and Veterinary qualification) Rules, 2017 framed under provisions of IVC Act, 1984.
- (f) There is no proposal under considerationabout reforms in the veterinary colleges in the private sector. However, VCI with the prior approval of the Central Government has framed the Minimum Standards of Veterinary Education Regulations, 2016 to ensure minimum standards in veterinary education including the physical facilities, infrastructure and manpower etc. to be made available for imparting in a recognized veterinary qualification. For the purpose, the colleges are inspected under the provision of section 19 & 20 of the IVC Act and the colleges are required to fulfill all the standards as laid down under the aforesaid Regulations. Further, the Central Government has also framed the VCI(Procedure for recognition and de-recognition of Veterinary colleges and Veterinary qualification) Rules, 2017 for laying down standards for opening of new veterinary college which equally apply in both private and government sector.
