INCENTIVISE AGRI START-UPS

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any funds have been released under any scheme to incentivise agri start-ups in rural areas of Pali Constituency of Rajasthan;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the details of other operational schemes to fund agri start-up in the area and its benefit to beneficiaries?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): The Government of India is committed to promote Agri-startups by providing financial and technical support to agri-startups in agriculture and allied sectors. Department of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare (DA&FW) is implementing "Innovation and Agri-Entrepreneurship Development" programme under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) from 2018-19 with an objective to promote innovation and agri-entrepreneurship by providing financial and technical support for nurturing startups ecosystem in the country. Under the programme, 5 Knowledge Partners (KPs) and 24 RKVY Agribusiness Incubators (R-ABIs) have been appointed for training & incubation of agri-startups and implementation of this programme across the country. In the State of Rajasthan, 2 incubation centers are located namely Ch. Charan Singh National Institute of Agricultural Marketing (CCS-NIAM) Jaipur and

Sri Karan Narendra (S K N) Agriculture University, <u>Jobner</u> to cater the need of agristartups in the State.

Under the programme, no disqualification is made in selection of startups with respect to specific constituency. The startup is selected based on the recommendation given by the Committee constituted for this purpose. So far, no startup has taken support from the rural areas of Pali Constituency of Rajasthan under the programme. However, the startup from Pali Constituency of Rajasthan may take technical and financial support through 5 KPs and 24 R-ABIs appointed by this Department under the programme as per the list at Annexure.

Under the programme, the financial assistance of Rs. 111.57 crores have been released in installments to a total of 1554 agri startups in the country including Rajasthan State through various KPs and R-ABIs from 2019-20 to 2023-24.
