Financial Assistance under PMMSY

566. SHRI RAMALINGAM S.:

Will the Minister of **FISHERIES**, **ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING** मत्स्यपालन, पशुपालन और डेयरी मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry has provided financial assistance under the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) to fish/prawn farmers in Mayiladuthurai and Nagappattinam districts for taking up activities such as establishment of need based brackishwater hatcheries and construction of new ponds for brackishwater aquaculture/saline/alkaline, etc., if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor during the last five years and the current year;
- (b) the number and details of proposals received from the State of Tamil Nadu under the National Programme for Dairy Development, Rashtriya Gokul Mission, Dairy Processing & Infrastructure Development Fund, Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana and Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund; and
- (c) the number of proposal that got in principal approval from the Government and its subsequent developments thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

(SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

(a): The Department of Fisheries, Government of India is implementing a flagship scheme namely "Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) with highest ever investment of Rs.20050 crore in fisheries sector in all the States/Union Territories (UTs) for a period of 5 years with effect from the financial year 2020-21. Under PMMSY, based on the project proposals received from State Government of Tamil Nadu, the Department of Fisheries, Government of India has accorded administrative approvals for the projects of total cost of Rs. 934.23 crore with central share of Rs.376.91 crore to the Government of Tamil Nadu from 2020-21 till date, which also includes activities of Establishment of need based New Brackish Hatcheries (shell fish and fin fish), Construction of New ponds for Brackish Water Aquaculture, Inputs for Brackish Water Aquaculture, Construction of Biofloc ponds for Brackish water/Saline/Alkaline areas including inputs. As informed by Government of Tamil Nadu, the details of activities for establishment of need based brackish water hatcheries and construction of new ponds for brackish water aquaculture/ saline/ alkaline in Mayiladuthurai and Nagappattinam districts, are given at Annexure-I.

(b) and (c): The Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying (DAHD), Government of India, is implementing Rashtriya Gokul Mission since 2014 with focus on development and conservation of indigenous bovine breeds, genetic upgradation of bovine population and enhancement of milk production and productivity of bovines thereby making milk production more remunerative to the farmers in all States/UTs in the country including Tamil Nadu. Total 12 Proposals received by DAHD from the State under Rashtriya Gokul Mission have been approved with total cost of Rs. 12992.29 lakh and communication has been sent to the State. The details of approved proposals are given at Annexure-II.

Under "National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD)" scheme implemented by DAHD, 9 projects have been received and approved to Tamil Nadu with the total project cost of Rs 25922.50 lakh with a Central share of Rs. 18210.30 lakh. Till date, an amount of Rs. 13642.395 lakh has been released to Tamil Nadu against which utilization of Rs.12024.193 lakh have been reported. The details of the approved projects are given at Annexure-III.

Under "Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund" scheme implemented by DAHD, as on 30.11.2023, 4 projects have sanctioned to Tamil Nadu with the total project cost of Rs. 285.82 Crore with loan component of Rs. 228.65 Crore. The details of the sanctioned projects as on 30.11.2023 are given at Annexure-IV.

Government of Tamil Nadu has submitted various project proposals towards the development of Fisheries Sector in the state under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) & Government of India has approved the following projects under PMMSY during the year 2020-21 to 2023-24.

Government of Tamil Nadu has submitted various project proposals towards the development of Fisheries Sector in the state under Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund scheme (FIDF) & Department of Fisheries, Government of India has approved 64 projects under FIDF with the total project cost of Rs.1574.73 Crore. As reported by Government of Tamil Nadu, 23 projects have been completed, 32 projects are in progress and 9 projects are yet to commence.
