# LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 60 TO BE ANSWERED ON 02.02.2024

#### IMPLEMENTATION OF PMMVY

60. SHRI RAM MOHAN NAIDU KINJARAPU:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the quantum of funds allotted and utilized for the implementation of Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) in the State of Andhra Pradesh during the last four years, district-wise;
- (b) the details regarding the total number of beneficiaries of the PMMVY scheme belonging to the Scheduled Tribes, Scheduled Castes and Other Backward Classes during the last four years, State/UT-wise, especially in Andhra Pradesh;
- (c) the total number of beneficiaries under the scheme who have only received the first instalment on account of not undertaking the second stage requirements during the last four years, especially in Andhra Pradesh; and
- (d) whether the Government has taken any promotional activities to increase awareness regarding the PMMVY scheme and if so, the details thereof, Statewise?

### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER FOR WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) Under Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY), more than 3.78 crores beneficiaries have been enrolled since inception of the Scheme in 2017-18 and till 29.01.2024. Further, maternity benefits of more than ₹14,758.87 crores have been disbursed to more than 3.29 crores beneficiaries during the aforesaid period.

Under PMMVY, funds are released on the basis of indicative target and utilization of previous year grants. Thus, no State-wise or district-wise allocations are made under PMMVY. The details of Central share of funds released to the State Government of Andhra Pradesh under PMMVY and utilization reported by the State Government during the last four years are as under:

- (b) The State/UT-wise (including the State of Andhra Pradesh) details of number of beneficiaries enrolled under PMMVY belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes during the last four years is **Annexed**. The Ministry does not maintain data of beneficiaries belonging to Other Backward Classes.
- (c) In order to receive all instalments of maternity benefits under PMMVY a beneficiary needs to apply and fulfil the conditionality attached with the instalment such as possession of Aadhaar, Ante-Natal Checkup (ANC), registration of child birth, first cycle of vaccination etc. Around 33,000 beneficiaries have received only first instalment in Andhra Pradesh during the last four years. The reasons for not receiving maternity benefits beyond first instalment inter-alia includes non-fulfilment of conditionality attached with the instalment, ANC, rejected, withdraw of application etc.
- (d) The Ministry of Women and Child Development (MWCD) is actively involved to support the Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra (VBSY) throughout the country. MWCD is participating under the "Meri Kahani Meri Zubani (MKMZ)" initiative under which the beneficiaries from each Gram Panchayats speak of their experiences and the impact that selected schemes of Government had on their lives. As per the VBSY dashboard, so far under MKMZ, 4.53 lakh beneficiaries from MWCD have narrated their experiences, including 2.42 lakh PMMVY beneficiaries, presenting their perspective about how these schemes have strengthened Nari Shakti.

"On-spot registrations" of eligible beneficiaries is also undertaken during the Yatra for saturation of scheme under MWCD. So far 2.17 lakh on-spot registrations have been reported under various schemes of MWCD including PMMVY.

Also, to oversee the support MWCD has been extending to VBSY across India and to make MWCD's contribution more meaningful, field visits of Ministry's senior officers and the Media team has also been initiated.

Apart from this, States/UTs also undertake various IEC and Behavior Change Communication (BCC) activities such as Prabhat Pheri, Nukkad Natak, Newspaper Advertisements, Airing Radio Jingles, Selfie Campaign, Door to Door Campaign, Community Programmes at field functionary level etc. Further, the Ministry is also running special campaign for registration of eligible beneficiaries in all States and UTs under PMMVY on a periodic basis.
