(a) to (c): The Government has approved continuation of the Central Sector Scheme "Broadcasting Infrastructure and Network Development (BIND)" with an outlay of Rs. 2539.61 crore for the period 2021-26 with various components for modernization and upgradation of Broadcasting Infrastructure and Network Development aimed at enhancing the physical infrastructure of Doordarshan and All India Radio. There is no change in total approved outlay under BIND Scheme.
